



Sign Up Now for DIRS – Disaster Information Reporting System

The Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) Media Bureau and Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (PSHSB) encourage radio and television broadcasters who have not yet voluntarily enrolled in the Commission's Disaster Information Reporting System (DIRS) to do so. The FCC further encourage radio and television broadcasters who are now enrolled in DIRS to update their contact information on a routine basis. The DIRS program provides the FCC with situational awareness about which licensed broadcast stations are operating during, and immediately following, a disaster or large-scale emergency; and it enables the Commission to act swiftly to help those broadcasters that are off-the air restore operations and provide important emergency-related information and updates to the public.
